

Description: Chichen Itza is one of the most famous Mayan archaeological sites in the world. Its name means "the mouth of the well of the Itza" and was an important political and economic center of Mayan civilization with magnificent structures as the Temple of Kukulcan, known as El Castillo, the Temple of Chac Mool, Temple of the Warriors and 1000 columns. The tour includes a visit to Ik-kil cenote and lunch buffet.
